

Executive Directors Recognition Award (EDRA)

The Executive Director may periodically present this award to outstanding contributors to the work of World Border Organization - BORDERPOL. It is the privilege of the Executive Director to solicit nominations and supporting documentation for the EDRA, consider that information and name the recipient.

The award itself is prepared by the Executive Director in consultation with the Secretary Treasurer, with suitable text, supplied by the nominator at the request of the ED, and is presented to the recipient at an appropriate time and venue. .

A notice requesting nominations for the EDRA will appear on the member's page at official website of BORDERPOL. (<http://www.borderpol.org>) The Award recipient is also announced at the official website by the Secretary Treasurer and the Director of Media at the time of selection.

Award Criteria

The EDRA is intended to provide timely recognition of BORDERPOL members, observers and outside supporters for their outstanding service or support to the organization.

1. The EDRA is a non-competitive award that consists of a certificate stating the contribution and a specially minted challenge pin.
2. The EDRA will originate with the Office of the Executive Director and will not be used for other purposes.
3. EDRA's may be presented annually but also on other occasions if the Executive Director deems such a presentation appropriate.
4. There will be no limit to the number of awards that may be presented at a particular annual meeting or special occasion.
5. Approval of EDRA's by the members of the Secretariat may be sought but is not compulsory.
6. EDRA's will be presented to living members and is not restricted by age, gender or status.
7. The cost of the EDRA challenge pin will be attributed to the discretionary budget of the Executive Director.
